## SPRING SHOW 2018

The Spring Show is one of two juried shows each year that the Topeka Art Guild sponsors. Members and non-members of the Topeka Art Guild are encouraged to enter. All artists who reside in Kansas are eligible to enter the show.

Cash awards are as follows: 1st Place \$300, 2nd Place \$200, 3rd Place \$100 and \$50 for the People's Choice Award. Four Honorable Mention awards will receive ribbons. Awards will be announced at First Friday April 6, 2018 at 6:30.

The Spring show will be on exhibit in our gallery from April 4 thru May 26, 2018. Entry date is April 1, 2018 from 2:00-4:00pm.

The juror for this show is Sue Shea.

Entries in 2D must be appropriately framed or gallery wrapped and have hanging wire properly secured on the back. Entries in 3D shall not exceed 48" in any direction, be preassembled, and stable without outside support. Artists will be notified of entries not accepted within five days of the entry day.

All works of art must be original to the artist and not done in a class or workshop. Entries may not have been shown at the Art Guild before and must have been created in the last two years.

Entry fees for members is \$15 for the first piece and \$10 for each additional piece with a limit of

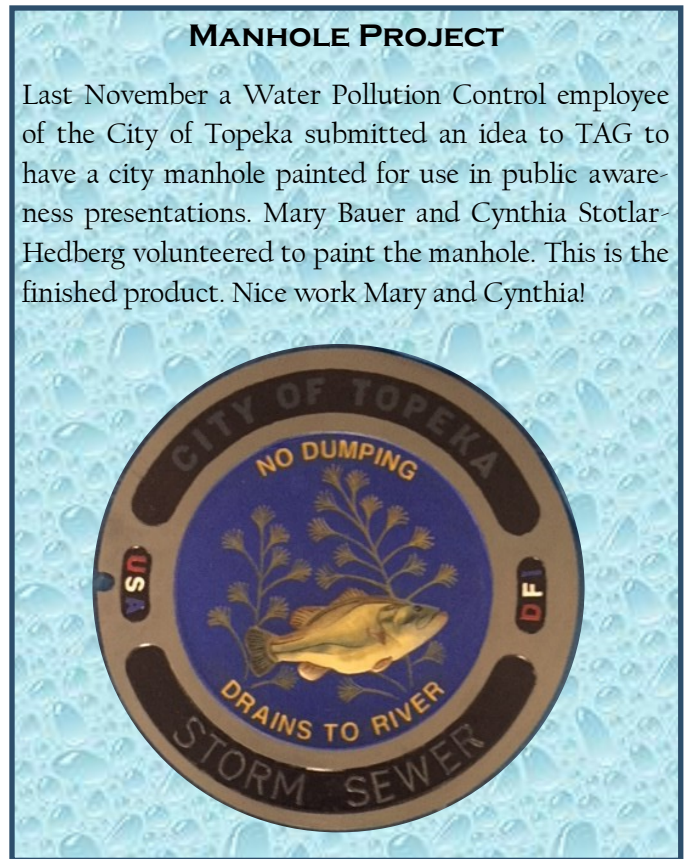

three pieces. The same fees apply to non-members plus a \$30 membership fee. Student fees are \$5 with a limit of three also. Entry fees are non-refundable.

All entries must be available for sale. The Art Guild will retain a commission of 45% on each piece sold or 30% if 12 hours of time has been volunteered to staff the Gallery.
